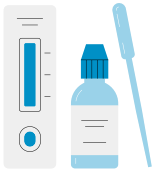




# Keeping our groups safe



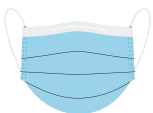
There are no plans to cancel groups at the moment. This will be assessed on a weekly basis. If a group is cancelled, we will give you as much notice as we can.



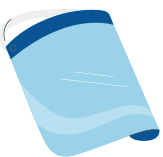
Staff will work from home where possible, and staff and volunteers will complete a lateral flow test **before** taking part in any face-to-face activities.



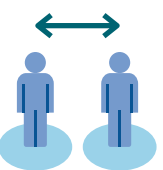
We will continue with our stringent hygiene measures, including regular hand washing, wiping down surfaces, and frequent use of hand sanitiser gel.



Masks must be worn at all times where possible. This is the best way to prevent spread of respiratory illness.



Where masks cannot be worn, a visor must be used instead to reduce risk of respiratory spread.



We will do our best to maintain social distancing of at least 1m where possible. Home visits will be delayed until after Christmas and assessments will take place via telephone where possible.



High standards of hygiene will be maintained on our transport, and all passengers will continue wearing masks and using hand sanitiser gel every trip.
